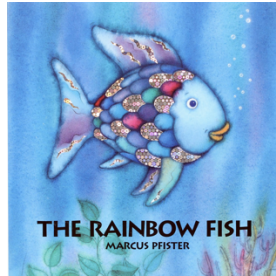


Summer Assignments for Rising Pre-K 4

We hope you are having fun in the sun and enjoying many summer activities!

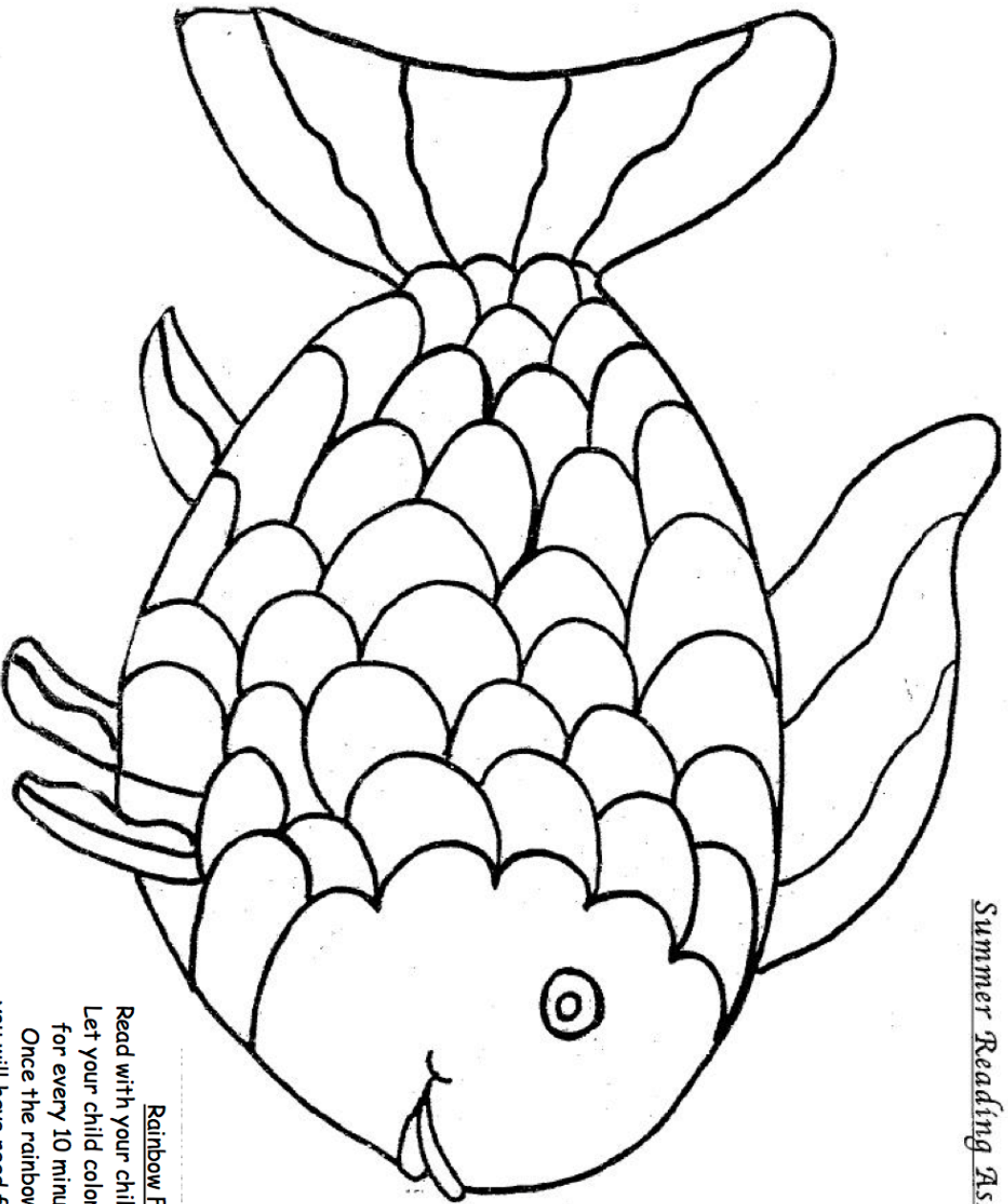
We are looking forward to seeing you in the fall and meeting all of our new classmates!
