Back to School Night - Thursday, August 18, 6:45-8:45pm

Middle School Back to School Night falls on the evening of the second day of school, Thursday, August 18. Parents wishing to meet their child's advisor should plan to join that advisor in their advisory location (Advisors should inform you of this via email in advance.), beginning at 6:45pm sharp. Parents not wishing to join their child's advisor's session should simply report to the middle and upper school dining hall by 7pm, when we will begin the formal event. After a 10-minute, opening program, teachers of the different classes will introduce themselves and provide brief snapshots of their classes and what students can expect. Please note that this is not the venue to discuss your individual student's performance in a given class. Teachers are very happy to schedule a meeting or phone call with you at another, mutually convenient time. We do hope to see most of you at Back to School Night!

Middle School Carpool Procedures

Arrival to School

Campus opens at 7:00am for students. So that we can provide appropriate supervision, students may not enter the building before this time. Students who arrive before 7:30am should be dropped off at the doors leading into the dining hall and Championship Gym (across the street from the wildcat statue). They will then report directly to the dining hall, where they will be supervised until 7:45am (Note: The School will serve breakfast in 2022-2023.). Those students wishing to be in the

library or design lab or go outside to the quad (weather permitting) may do so beginning at 7:30am. Students may not enter the second floor of the middle school building until 7:45, unless they are attending math lab or have an appointment with a teacher.

Students who arrive on campus after 8:00am (8:05am in the Upper School) must have their parents call the middle school office to announce their child's arrival and the reason for lateness. The student will report to the middle school office and receive a pass to either their advisory or first class. Those students without valid reasons for lateness will receive a tardy for the day.

Dismissal

Students who have siblings at the Lower School may meet their rides in the parking lot north of the football field so that parents do not have to make another loop in the carpool line. Students should take care when crossing the street by the Wildcat statue. Students may NOT be picked up at the Championship Gym between 3:30pm and 4:00pm or in the Upper School student parking lot. Students exiting from these locations may be subject to disciplinary action.

Middle school students who do not have siblings at the lower school must wait in the designated grade-level pick-up area.

6th Grade: Covered area outside the main, middle school carpool line doors

7th Grade: Overhang at the end of the carpool line **8th Grade:** Overhang at the end of the carpool line

When the quad is open and supervised, students who are planning to attend Aftercare may be here until 4pm when they must report to the Middle School Aftercare room, Room 108.

Picking Up/Dropping Off Your Child For An Appointment

Though not ideal, students need to go to various appointments that can only be made during the academic day. When a parent needs to pick up their child during school hours, they need only call the middle school office **after** they arrive on campus, and then they should wait in their car by the middle school doors for their child to come out to meet them. A middle school office staff person will call the child out of class and send them to their car.
