Dear Lower School Parents,

I hope that you are all having a wonderful, restful summer. While I do not want to rush the end of summer, I do want to provide you with some information to help you plan for the 2021-2022 school year.

You will notice that I am not including COVID protocols in this email. We are still working through those plans, and Dr. Griffin will share those details with you in an email soon. I will also provide more specific Lower School protocols closer to the start of school.

### Student Orientation Schedule - ALL STUDENTS, Monday, August 16

All students (PK-5) will attend in-person orientation with their teachers on Monday, August 16. There are two time slots and students should attend during the designated time based on their last name. These sessions will be for **students only**. Students should follow standard carpool flow and be dropped off in the <u>designated locations</u> based on their grade level. Students should wear face coverings as they move from their car to their classroom and while in their school building. Teachers will be at drop off to guide students to their classrooms.
