WHO: Any Episcopal student age 16 and over and any parent of an Episcopal student

The vaccine administered will be the Pfizer-BioNTech version, which requires a two dose protocol. The second dose will be administered at another on-campus clinic on Thursday, April 29, for which there will be a separate registration process. Please note, anyone receiving the vaccine must complete a 15 minute waiting period before leaving the site.

Please register by the end of today (Tuesday, April 6). Arrangements must be made for the correct number of doses. Appointments will be made in 15 minute time slots with a limited number of spaces available within each 15 minute period. *Please be punctual.*

Attach a copy of your insurance card to the form.

Blank forms are also available in each school division office. A separate form is required for each person. There is no cost to you for the vaccine, but insurance information is requested on the form and a copy of your insurance card must be attached to the form.
