Attendance: As we are holding core classes in each of the grade levels, students need to be sure to check in (for attendance purposes) with the appropriate teacher on Google Chat during the times in the schedule that these classes normally meet. Teachers of the core classes will take attendance through Google Chat and enter it into Veracross. Make sure you join the group chat when your class would be starting. For example, 4th period will join their google chat at 8:15 Monday morning whereas 6th period will join at 11:05.

Students are also able to ask questions and get help via the Google Chat group that Ms. Stoltz

created. The group is titled "Middle School Student Technology Helpline," and students received an invitation to join the group earlier this weekend. Any student can ask for help with a technology issue by creating a new thread in this group--our technology team along with Ms. Stoltz and I will be monitoring this group and offering help, but students are also encouraged to answer their classmates' questions when they can.
