



Senior-Year Application Check List

- Register for Fall and/or Winter ACTs AND SATs. Schedule on back.**
 - Code in colleges of interest to receive test results.
 - Enter high school code number (041417) when registering.
- Meet briefly with college counselor to review college plans.**
- Draft college application essay(s).**
- Finalize college application list by October 15. (Sept. 15 for EA/ED)**
- Submit Teacher Recommendation Request to teacher(s) by October 15. (Sept. 15 for EA/ED)**
- Submit Résumé to college counselor by October 15. (Sept. 15 for EA/ED)**
- Enter TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS on Naviance. (At least *1 MONTH* prior to college's application deadline AND NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 30)**
- Meet with visiting college reps from the colleges to which you are applying. (schedule on Naviance)**
- Submit FAFSA, and possibly CSS Profile, for financial assistance. (CSS Profile – Oct–Dec; FAFSA – Jan/Feb)**
- KNOW the various pieces required to complete your applications for admission.**
- Submit applications by deadline.**
 - Just meet deadlines. Date by which application is submitted is not an admissions factor.
 - However, apply in early fall to large public universities with ROLLING admission process.
- Have SAT/ACT scores sent to colleges to which you are applying.**
- Apply for Arkansas Governor's Distinguished Scholarship at adhe.edu by Feb. 1.**
- Enter admission decisions on Naviance and bring in scholarship-offer letters for documentation.**
- Submit Enrollment Deposit to ONE college by May 1.**
 - If wait-listed to top choice, submit deposit to 2nd choice.
 - Inform College Advisor of plan to pursue wait-list.
- Officially decline offer to attend other colleges that have admitted you by May 1 also.**
- Apply for Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship (lottery) at adhe.edu by June 1.**
- Your Final Transcript is automatically submitted to your college choice without having to request it.**
